STOP LAND CLEARING AT LEE POINT.

Land clearing 100 ha of native forest at Lee Point has started. Instead of cutting CO2 emissions and protecting our biodiversity from extinction, the NT Government is:

- Bulldozing the pristine habitat of the endangered Black Footed Tree Rat, vulnerable Darwin Cycad and hundreds of other species
- Permanently changing Casuarina Coastal Reserve, critical habitat for the threatened Flatback Turtle and international migrating shorebirds, leaving behind a fragmented ecosystem
- Ignoring proper planning processes and preparing to house thousands of people at Lee Point

Casuarina Coast Reserve, the NT's most visited nature park, will never be the same again.

Minister for Planning, Environment and Climate Change, Eva Lawler, has the legal power to stop this immediately. It's time she takes her responsibility to act on climate change seriously.
